How can we help people who are suffering?

Our God does not leave us in the dark with unanswered questions and fears about the biggest questions of life. He gave them to us early on in Biblical history, though many people don't see this because they don't know the correct dating of Job or the truth of the statements in it—this lesson series will help you understand the dating of it and then why you can trust these answers in it and Genesis.

If, in contrast, we are just looking at history and validation of some old books that may or may not be important to us, why bother?
